**Re Official Information Act Request**

I refer to your Official Information Act request dated 01 January 2016 requesting the following information:

- **How many deceased organ donors were there for the 2015 calendar year?**

There were 53 deceased organ donor in NZ in 2015.

- **How many organ donors did not have their organs retrieved or transplanted into another person for 2015?**

There were three organ donors in 2015 where no organs were transplanted.

- **A copy of the most recent death audit.**

A copy is enclosed.

**I understand that the College of intensive Care Medicine (CICM) has withdrawn accreditation for the training of doctors in Intensive Care Medicine from DCCM effective December 2015, assuming remedial actions are not instituted.**

- **Has accreditation been withdrawn?**

The Department of Critical Care Medicine (DCCM) at Auckland DHB had training accreditation withdrawn by the College of Intensive Care Medicine (CICM) on 20 November, 2014.

- **If not, what remedial actions have been instituted?**

The CICM accreditation review recommended changes in practice to enable better teaching and supervision opportunities. The CICM has been invited to revisit the Department of Critical Care Medicine to assess progress on recommendations with a view to having our accreditation status reinstated. The trainees working within DCCM have not been disadvantaged because the College of Intensive Care Medicine undertook to approve the training time of trainees who had already been appointed to work until the end of 2015. At no stage has there been any concern raised about the quality of care provided to our patients and we are certain that this remains of a very high standard.

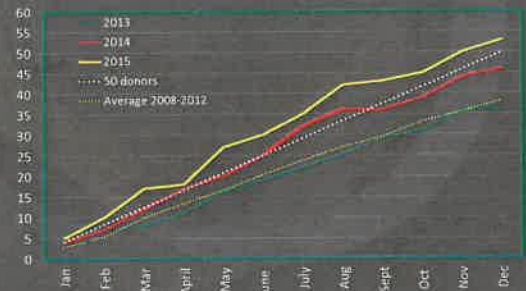
